T Clark	Skipper of the boat catching the best shark of the season anywhere in the UK
Fisherman's Protection	Most sharks in a normal 8 /9 hour day (Looe only) – <i>due to wear and tear, a salver is being presented in place of this trophy</i>
Dusty Miller	Skipper with most sharks of qualifying size during the season
Fred & Betty Reid Memorial Cup	Skipper with first qualifying shark of the season (Looe only) - <i>due to wear and tear, a salver is being presented in place of this trophy</i>
Kingerlee Trophy	Best shark of the season by non member skipper (Looe only)
Chairmans Trophy	Skipper with first shark of the calendar year

Mustad Skipper Trophy

For the Skipper of the boat from which the largest shark of the season is caught, measured and released

Unless otherwise stated all skippers trophies are only awarded to skippers who are SACGB members

Unless otherwise stated the claim period for all trophies is “during the season” 1st October to 30th September, and only for sharks caught and released in British waters.

The R C Roberts trophy is open to non-members and will be awarded to the winning applicant provided they join the club at the time the application is made.

The minimum total points of a shark which may be entered for any of the Clubs trophies, is 110 points, unless in certain circumstances a challenge trophy may be awarded by weight or species. This will be at the discretion of the committee.

All sharks must have been released in good condition back into the water

The “Best Shark” will always be the one who’s estimated weight is the greatest when expressed as a percentage of the weight of the British Record for that particular species

All trophy claims must be made on the Clubs Trophy Declaration Form

The number of points is determined by combining the length of the shark, from the tip of the nose to the fork of the tail, and the girth measurement in inches (around the body to the front of the dorsal fin but excluding the dorsal fin).

All trophy claims must be verified and signed by a witness and must be accompanied by photographic/video evidence or such other evidence that the committee shall deem appropriate from time to time. The committee decision with all claims will be final
